

RESPONSES TO VIOLENT INTRUDERS IN PLACES OF WORSHIP



The Flint Township Police Department is presenting a two hour seminar on security issues in places of worship. This program is based on the ALICE training institute techniques. (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) Our instructor led class provides preparation and a plan for individuals and organizations on how to more proactively handle the threat of an aggressive intruder or active shooter event. Whether it is an attack by an individual person or by a group intent on conveying a political message through violence, ALICE Training option based tactics have become the accepted response, versus the traditional "lockdown only" approach.

The course, presented by members of the Flint Township Police Department who are ALICE certified instructors, is ideal for clergy and others who are involved or may become involved in maintaining security at their facilities.
